Terms and Conditions

Promoter	Mondelez Australia Pty Ltd (ABN 78 004 551 473), Level 10, 75 Dorcas Street, South Melbourne VIC 3205.
Competition Period	12.01am (AEST) on 26/08/2026 to 11.59pm (AEST) on 22/09/2026.
Who can enter?	Only Australian residents who are aged 18 or over.
Who can't enter?	Directors, officers, management, employees and contractors (and their immediate families) of: (a) the Promoter; (b) BP Australia Pty Ltd and relevant entities; and (c) the agencies, companies or participating premises associated with this competition. "Immediate family" means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
Where will the competition run?	The competition will run in any BP retail stores in Australia, where Cadbury products are sold (Stores). Purchases made from Stores using third party delivery services (e.g. UberEats, Doordash) will be accepted.

Qualifying Purchase	Any two eligible Cadbury products from a Store, in a single transaction and on the same Store receipt. Entry
